We received news this morning that one of our volunteer team members was killed in the collapse of a guest house in Port au Prince during the sudden and devastating earthquake that struck Haiti yesterday.

We are deeply saddened by this loss, and wish to express our sincere sympathy to her family. We also extend our sympathy to the families of other foreign relief workers injured or missing and to the people of Haiti affected by this disaster.
