Learn Coaching Skills

Track 1: Training Curriculum

Track 1 Training orients those registering to the GC2 coaching and network facilitation ethos. Coaching and networking are resource tools to help equip leaders and workers in local churches plan and lead ministries that result in "Great Commission" and "Great Commandment" fulfillment.

The two days of training involves some lecture, as well as demonstration sessions and skill development exercises that create basic competency to begin coaching.

The Track 1 Training Curriculum includes:

- The importance of networks and coaching
- The EMCC "GC2" Network
- Definition of coaching
- Biblical basis of coaching
- Coaching skills – listening, observing, asking questions, motivation
- Coaching demonstrations
- Coaching qualifications
- Coaching resources
- Forming a coaching relationship
- Planning a coaching encounter
- Task of coaching – follow-up, celebrating, resourcing, training, etc.
- The coaching relationship – forming, maintaining, changing, disengaging
- Setting up a Coaching "Practicum"

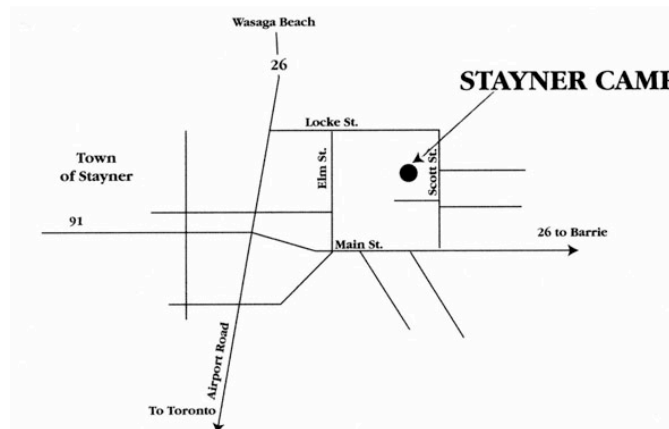
Track 2: Training
