- OUT with the crowds relational, intentional, transformational
 (Luke 6:12-19 mentoring, teaching, miracles)


2. Proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom




4. Teach, Imitate, Model (Jesus' example)


5. Equip, Empower, Release, Check-in



 - **UP** with the Father
 - Living out the ways, words, works of Jesus

- Teach, Imitate, Model (Paul's example)

- Imitate 1 Cor. 11:1
- Model 1 Tim. 4:12.
- OUT with the crowds relational, intentional, transformational Luke 6:12-19
 - 'I am sending you...' John 20:21
 - Proclaim the Gospel Luke 10:9; Mark 1:15

2. Make Disciples in community:

- Invite a few to "be with" you
- Imitate Jesus, Model, Learn/Discover together
- Equip, empower, release, check-in
- Surrender control to the Holy Spirit (coaching)
- Live with authenticity, transparency, accountability

3. Make Disciples who make Disciples to 4th

- Multiply Disciple-making huddles
- Apprentice people in the Way of Jesus
- Could use Way of Jesus Scope & Sequence

- Create a Disciple-Making Culture

- Use common language
- Tell Disciple Making stories
- Model life-on-life transformation
