Continue steadfastly in prayer, being watchful with thanksgiving.


ews about what is happening around the world filters down to us every day. Beautiful images promoted by travel companies. Heart-breaking stories filled with hurt and anger in the news. Random pieces of information on social media about friends who live abroad. We feel connected with the rest of the world more than ever before in history. What would Paul have tweeted when he got shipwrecked on Malta? Or when he and Barnabas disagreed and went separate ways? What would Peter have written on his blog after visiting the home of Cornelius, a Roman centurion?

When they wrote to the churches they asked for people to join them in prayer, not just for their work but for them. As disciple-makers were sent out to plow spiritual ground that was rocky and rough, they understood that being sent in Jesus' name was risky business. The same is true to this day. Doing something in Jesus' name means spending time with Him, listening to Him and doing what He asks. It is spiritual work that takes spiritual energy as well as physical effort. It is no easier for missionaries than for anyone else. Paul knew that, so he asked for prayer. Our missionaries know it and so they ask for prayer.

Today we can follow our missionaries in so many ways! Newsletters. emails, blogs, Facebook, Pinterest, Twitter...we can see life through their eyes in ways that the early church never could. We can feel involved! We can pray more specifically without having to being told as much. We can celebrate together. We can cry together. But communication and interaction is not enough. Missionaries need your prayers.

Prayer is the nutrient base of the missionary—God working in them and for them as they seek to make Him known around the world. It feeds them. As you work your way through the calendar with us, know that the Holy Spirit is faster than any broadband speed. In the moment you pray, God is there with you as well as the one you are praying for. Watch as He transforms impossible situations into celebrations. Watch as He infuses purpose back into a hopeless heart wrecked with discouragement. Watch as your prayers for our missionaries move the hand of God to change the world.


